Lunch stop at PA exit 14 at approximately Noon We plan on being here 1 hour.
1:00 p.m. follow I-79 South to I-68
I-68 to I-70 158 miles to the next exit
Exit 18 for MD 68
M 68 east to Alt US 40
Alt US 40 for 36 miles to I-70
Merge onto I-70 East for 32 miles *See Alt Route for heavy traffic
Exit 80 MD 32 for 33 miles
Exit 12 for Rte 1 South to Laurel

Follow Rte 1 to the Days Inn & Suites
We should arrive at approximately 6:30 p.m.

Alt Route if traffic is heavy on I-70 after Alt 40
Exit 68 MD 27 South to MD 144 East
MD 144 is the Old National Pike
16.5 miles (approx) we will come to MD 32
Then follow directions to Rte 1
